

Safeguarding - What you can do.

Parents and carers play a role in safeguarding children in their community. If you have any concerns, no matter how small, you should report them to someone who you trust will listen. The school is required to have a designated child protection officer for this purpose. Parents and children should speak to the safeguarding officer if they have any concerns about a child or staff member.

If you think a child or young person may be in immediate danger, call 999.

Nottinghamshire's Multi-Agency Safeguarding Hub (MASH) operates between the hours of 08:30-17:00 Monday to Thursday and 08:30-16:30 on Friday. For any urgent concerns about a child or if you wish to report a concern anonymously, please contact them on 0300 500 80 80. If you require an urgent response outside of these hours, contact the Emergency Duty Team (EDT) on 0300 456 4546.
