I wrote in October 2023 to inform you that the formal decision of our Cabinet Member taken in September to increase school meal prices was being considered under the Authority's call-in process.

This process has now concluded, and we are now in a position to implement the proposed meal prices we had originally communicated in early September. The new prices will be implemented from Monday 4th December 2023, and for ease are detailed in the table below.
