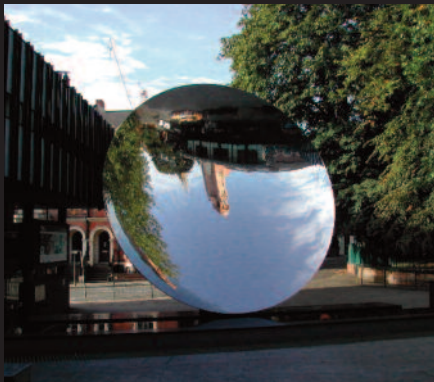

STRING EXPERIENCE

Saturday - SENIOR STRINGS (Grade 5 - 8+) Sunday - JUNIOR STRINGS (Grade 2 - 4)

Who is it for?

For violinists, violists, cellists and bassists aged 8-21, grouped by ability, to enjoy an exploration of repertoire, technique and performance through the expertise of professional conductors - Chris George (senior group), Rowan Cozens (junior group).

What are we playing?

SENIOR ORCHESTRA: Led by a professional string quartet the senior orchestra will study Bach's *Brandenburg Concerto No 3* and movements from Grieg's *Holberg Suite*. The workshop day will culminate in a Festival Concert at the Albert Hall, ending with a spectacular performance of 'Light of the Seven' from *Game of Thrones*. This will feature all performers plus the mighty Binns organ and Steinway grand piano!

JUNIOR ORCHESTRA: Music especially chosen for young players including the well known *Sailor's Hornpipe*, as performed at the Last Night of the Proms!

WIND BAND EXPERIENCE

Saturday - SENIOR BAND (Grade 5 - 8+) Sunday - JUNIOR BAND (Grade 2 - 4)

Who is it for?

This unique playing day for all wind band players (brass, woodwind and percussion) aged 8 to 21, grouped according to ability, offers a rich experience in technique, performance and repertoire through the expertise of top clarinettist and conductor, Chris Swann.

What are we playing?

SENIOR WIND BAND: Featuring 'star of the future' clarinettist, Oliver Lee, from the Royal Northern College of Music, the senior band will study Weber's *Concertino* and the lively overture, *A Huntingdon Celebration* written by legendary band composer, Philip Sparke.

The workshop day will culminate in a Festival Concert at the Albert Hall, ending with a spectacular performance of 'Light of the Seven' from *Game of Thrones*. This will feature all performers plus the mighty Binns organ and Steinway grand piano!

Saturday - SENIOR GROUP (aged 12 - 25) Sunday - BIG FAMILY SING (children aged 5 - 11 + adults)

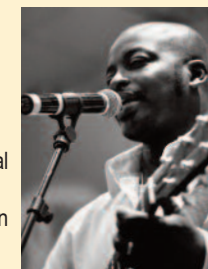
Who is it for?
