Phonics screening check by the end of Year 2

Thirteen children were rescreened.

8/13 attained the expected standard = 61.5%

5 boys and 3 girls

5/13 did not reach the expected standard = 38.4%

1 boy and 4 girls

This means that by the end of Y2:

54/59 have met the expected standard = 91.5%

5/ 59 have not met the expected standard and will require daily phonics in Y3 = 8%

Disadvantaged 4/5 attained the expected standard = 80%

Non disadvantage 49/54 attained the expected standard = 90.7%
