#### <u>Absences</u>



All absences from school must be reported to the school office. Messages via dojo are not always picked up by teachers in the morning due to the busy nature of the school day. If the main phone line is not answered there is the option to leave an answer phone message.

I would also like to state that teachers do not have the authority to

authorise any absensces, there are guidelines as to what can and cannot be classed as an authorsised absence (there are very few) and it is myself who has the final say. All requests for a leave of absensce must be received by the office. Teachers should not be asked if an absence can be authorised as this puts them in a very difficult posistion.
